

## Surahs for Level E (Grade 7 & 8)

**Note:** These Surahs do not need to be memorized. Only multiple choice questions will be asked from the translation.

### 92: AL-LAIL

This Sūrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 21 verses.

*In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful*

By the night, as it covers *with darkness*;<sup>[1]</sup> and by the day, as it spreads its brightness;<sup>[2]</sup> and by Him Who created the male and the female;<sup>[3]</sup> surely, your efforts are directed towards various ends.<sup>[4]</sup> So for him who gives *in charity*, fears *Allah*<sup>[5]</sup> and testifies to goodness,<sup>[6]</sup> We shall facilitate for him the Path to good.<sup>[7]</sup> As for him who is stingy and considers himself independent of *Allah*<sup>[8]</sup> and rejects the goodness,<sup>[9]</sup> We shall facilitate for him the Path to evil.<sup>[10]</sup> What benefit will he get from his wealth, if he himself is doomed.<sup>[11]</sup> Surely, it is for Us to give guidance,<sup>[12]</sup> and surely, to Us belong the end and the beginning.<sup>[13]</sup> Therefore, I warn you of the blazing fire,<sup>[14]</sup> in which none shall burn except the most wretched,<sup>[15]</sup> who denies the truth and gives no heed.<sup>[16]</sup> But the pious believer will be kept away from it,<sup>[17]</sup> the one who spends in charity for self-purification,<sup>[18]</sup> not seeking any favor from anyone for which a reward is expected in return,<sup>[19]</sup> except seeking the good pleasure of his Rabb, the Most High.<sup>[20]</sup> *Such a person shall soon be well-pleased with Allah.*<sup>[21]</sup>

## 93: AD-DUHÂ

This Sûrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 11 verses.

*In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful*

By the morning day light,<sup>[1]</sup> and by the night when it grows dark and still,<sup>[2]</sup> your Rabb has neither forsaken you, *O Muhammad*, nor is He displeased with you.<sup>[3]</sup> Certainly, the later life shall be better for you than the earlier.<sup>[4]</sup> Soon your Rabb shall grant you something with which you will be well-pleased.<sup>[5]</sup> Did He not find you an orphan and gave you shelter?<sup>[6]</sup> Did He not find you lost (*unaware of the faith, the Qur'an, and the Prophethood*) and gave you guidance?<sup>[7]</sup> Did He not find you poor and made you self-sufficient?<sup>[8]</sup> Therefore, do not treat the orphan with harshness<sup>[9]</sup> and do not chide away the beggar,<sup>[10]</sup> and speak gratefully about the bounty of your Rabb.<sup>[11]</sup> 93:[1-11]

This Sūrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 8 verses.

*In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful*

By the fig and by the olive,<sup>[1]</sup> by the mount of Sinai<sup>[2]</sup> and by this city of peace (Makkah).<sup>[3]</sup> We have indeed created man in the best stature,<sup>[4]</sup> then We return him to the lowest of the low<sup>[5]</sup> - except those who believe and do good deeds - for they shall have a never ending reward.<sup>[6]</sup> So, what causes you - *O disbelievers* - to deny the Day of Judgment?<sup>[7]</sup> Is not Allah the most just of all Judges?<sup>[8]</sup>
