

Therefore, offer Salah (prayer) to your Rabb and sacrifice. Surely, your enemy is the one who will be cut off from the root. 108:[1-3]




109: AL-KÂFIRÛN

This Surah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 6 verses.

Say: O unbelievers!^[1] I do not worship that which you worship,^[2] nor do you worship that which I worship,^[3] I shall never worship that which you worship,^[4] nor will you ever worship that which I worship.^[5] You have your religion, and I have mine.^[6] 109:[1-6]




112: AL-IKHLÂS





113: AL-FALAQ


