
JUZ:1 1: AL-FÂTIHA This Sürah, revealed at Makkah, has I section and 7 verses In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful. [1] All praise is for Allah, the Rabb of the Worlds.[2] The Compassionate, the Merciful, [3] Master of the Day of Judgment. [4] You Alone we worship and You Alone we call on for help. [5] Guide us to The Right Way, [6] The Way of those whom You have favored; not of those who have earned Your wrath, or of those who have lost The Way. 171 [Âmeen] 1:[1-7]

108: AL-KAUTHAR

This Surah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 3 verses.

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

O Muhammad, surely, We have granted you the Kauthar (countless blessings - it is also the name of a special fountain which will be granted to Prophet Muhammad on the Day of Judgment). Therefore, offer Salah (prayer) to your Rabb and sacrifice. Surely, your enemy is the one who will be cut off from the root. 108:[1-3]




109: AL-KÂFIRÛN

This Súrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 6 verses.

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

Say: O unbelievers!^[1] I do not worship that which you worship,^[2] nor do you worship that which I worship.^[3] I shall never worship that which you worship,^[4] nor will you ever worship that which I worship.^[5] You have your religion, and I have mine.^[6] 109:[1-6]



110: AN-NASR

This Sûrah, revealed at Madinah, has 1 section and 3 verses.

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

When there comes the help of Allah and the victory, [1] you see people embracing Allah's religion (*Islam*) in multitudes. [2] So, glorify your Rabb with His praises, and ask for His forgiveness: surely, He is ever ready to accept the repentance and forgive. [3]




111: AL-MASAD / AL-LAHAB

This Sûrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 5 verses

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

Perish be the hands of Abu Lahab! And perish be he!^[1] His wealth and whatever he earned (children) shell not avail him anything.^[2] Soon he shall be burnt in a flaming fire (a pun on the meaning of Abu Lahab, "father of flames"),^[3] and his wife, the carrier of firewood (to put thorns in the Prophet's path and slander him - the word firewood was used by Arabs to allude to slander and backbiting),^[4] shall have a rope of palm-leaf fibre around her neck.^[5]




112: AL-IKHLÂS

This Sùrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 4 verses.

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

Say: "He is Allah the One and Only; [1] Allah is the Self-Sufficient (independent of all, while all are dependent on Him); [2] He begets not, nor is He begotten (he has no child, nor is He a child of any one); [3] And there is none comparable to Him." [4] 112:[1-4]




113: AL-FALAQ

This Slrah, revealed at Makkah, has I section and 5 verses.

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful

Say: "I seek refuge with the Rabb of the dawn^[1] from the evil of all that He has created,^[2] and from the evil of darkness when it overspreads,^[3] from the evil of those who blow in knots,^[4] and from the evil of the envier when he envies."^[5] 113:[1-5]




This Sûrah, revealed at Makkah, has 1 section and 6 verses.
