[3] On that Day, it shall report whatever had happened on it, [4] for your Rabb shall have commanded it to do so. [5] On that Day, men shall proceed in sorted out groups to be shown their Deeds. [6] Then, whoever has done an atom's weight of good shall see it there, [7] and whoever has done an atom's weight of evil shall see it there. [8]

By the snorting steeds (horses that are used in wars), [1] dashing off sparks by the strike of their hoofs, [2] making raids in the morning, [3] and leaving a trail of dust [4] as they dash into the middle of the enemy troops! [5] Surely, man is ungrateful to his Rabb; [6] and surely, he himself bears witness to it, [7] and surely, he is ardently devoted in his love of this worldly wealth. [8] Is he not aware that when those who lie in the graves will be raised to life, [9] and that which is in their hearts will be made known, [10] surely, their Rabb on that Day, shall be Well-Acquainted with them. 

Would that you knew through the real knowledge provided to you in this Qur'an and care about your life in the Hereafter.[5] Because on the Day of Judgment when you see the Blazing Fire (hell),[6] and see it with the certainty of your own eyes[7] you shall believe it, but that belief is going to do you no good because - on that Day, you shall be questioned about the blessings (faculties and resources that you were given in the worldly life - as to how you used them?) [8]
